Asthma and other breathing problems are usually the first to feel the effects of smoke," Ms Goldman said. "Parents and carers of people with asthma need to be on the alert during bush fire season because wood smoke can trigger a flare-up or even a potentially fatal attack," she said. "During this period it is absolutely vital that people keep taking their asthma medication. We are advising all people with asthma to carry their reliever medication at all times and to take their preventer medication regularly, as it can take some weeks to be fully effective. On days when wood smoke levels are high, people should consider the places they intend to visit and weigh up the risks carefully."




