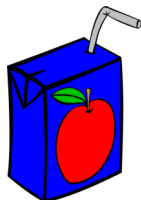
Much of the money we have raised this year is going towards lining and painting the internal walls of the COLA. It should be looking much nicer when everyone returns next year!

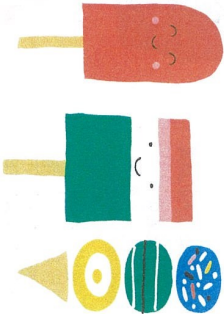

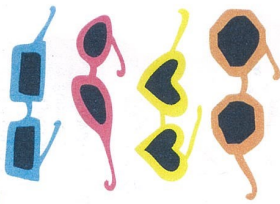
