School Information

POP payment system

This payment option is available on our school website. Access the website (www.blackhill-p.schools.nsw.edu.au) and the payment tab at the top of the page. When you access the \$Make a Payment you must enter:

STUDENT'S NAME & DATE OF BIRTH Only enter the fields that have an asterisk beside them.

These details are entered each time hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner and are not passed back to the school. You have the ability to check and

change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed at the time of payment. Payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. A further receipt will not be issued by the school. For any enquiries regarding the Online Payment process, please contact the office.

Note: Payment Ref as indicated on our permission note must be quoted. Also, write your POP receipt number on the student permission note & return to school.

Student Absence Notification

A reminder that if your child is absent from school, please notify the office between 8am and 9.15am.
