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



Vacation Care Information

Bookings are essential for Vacation Care Programs, families at the time of booking need to supply Vacation Care Booking Form as well as a current family registration form and approved Immunisation Records Things you'r child needs to hring to Vacation Care each day.

Things your child needs to bring to Vacation Care each day...

- Comfortable Play Clothes - that your child can happily have fun, get messy and not have to worry about

- the odd paint splash. We encourage your child to have fun with all activities and this includes messy play - A School Bag that your child can manage to put things in each day.
- A Drink Bottle that your child can use on their own with water inside.
- Sets of spare clothes in your child's bag just in case. It is very important for your child to be in their own clothing especially if they are upset. If your child is changed during the day, you will find their clothes at reception, labelled with their name and dated for you to take home and wash that day. It is very important for your child to bring in their own change of clothes and hat. If children don't have a change of clothes or hat with them and the Centre is required to provide children with a change of clothes or hat your account will be charged the cost of items supplied (\$15 per item), unfortunately due to Health Policies we cannot supply spare clothes.
- Comfortable shoes for active outdoor play please "No Thongs", these are very dangerous when children
 are climbing on equipment.
- A small pillow and sheet set if you would like your child to rest during our quiet activity time
- Additional food if your child doesn't like the food on the menu. The Centre promotes Healthy eating and we have a large number of children with allergies. High risk products such as nuts are not to be packed

Learn how to use a trampoline correctly, and perform skills safely at the same time as having lots of fun. The program incorporates the Olympic sized trampolines, tumble tramp, pit tramp, double mini tramp, single mini tramp and foam pit.

Skills Clinic: 8yrs + the "Skills Clinic" is a workshop style program for individuals wanting to learn key floor base skills for gymnastics, dance, cheerleading and aerobics. During this 1.5hr program participants will learn progressions for aerial cartwheels, forward and backward walkovers, leaps and jumps and more.
Ninja Kids (6-9yrs) & Ninja Teens (10-14yrs): Throughout this program we are able to replicate some of the activities seen on TV but also introduce many other fun activities that will challenge all participants. As so much of the ninja activities are based on gymnastic type movement, our qualified staff are able to not only provide a fun and engaging program but also feedback so each individual can improve.
