These practices include having high expectations of your child, using explicit teaching in the classroom. In addition, research shows that greater levels of support and engagement from parents and carers are associated with better student academic and wellbeing outcomes. We also know that students learn more effectively when the home and school environments form complementary. The Department of Education has now released a 'What works best' resource for parents and carers, which provides tips for having conversations with your child about their learning.
