


MATION P&C NEWS

FROM THE P&C

For your information there is a Black Hill Public School Uniforms Facebook page where parents can buy and sell second hand uniforms! It's called *Black Hill Public School Uniforms*.

All NSW school-enrolled children are eligible for two \$100 Active Kids vouchers each year. The vouchers can be used with any approved Active Kids provider, to help cover costs towards registration or membership fees for sport and active recreation. Voucher one is valid January to December and voucher two is valid July to December. After 1 July 2020, the second voucher can be claimed immediately after the first voucher. *Vouchers can always be found in your My Service NSW account by looking in the My Applications tab or Visit https://www.service.nsw.gov.au /transaction/apply-active-kidsvoucher
