A small amount of other colours is OK. School shorts/skorts will be blue and that is fine! 2022 Reptile Park Excursion Information Reminder.

This Thursday, 17th of November, the K-2 students will be travelling to the Reptile Park in Gosford for an excursion. We will be seeing a special show on the day at 10:00am and will need to leave the school by 8:30am to make it in time.

Departure: All students need to be in the front area of the school by 8:15am to have

rolls marked.

The bus will depart no later than 8:30am.

Return: We will be leaving the Reptile Park at 1:30pm. We expect to arrive back to

school at approximately 2:30pm (depending on traffic on the way home).

Uniform: Students are to wear their school uniform. School hats must be worn at all

times during the excursion. Depending on the weather, pack sunscreen, a

jumper, raincoat, etc.

Food: Students will NOT be allowed to purchase food.

Please pack enough food for recess and lunch & supply enough suitable drinks,

including water.

Remember to pack **NUT FREE** products please.

Students will need to take a small backpack as they will be required to

carry all of their own belongings all day long.

Parents: Parents that are coming on the excursion will be responsible for a small group

of students on the day. Our expression of interest for the excursion was completed and we thank all of the parents who offered to help. If you have your declaration for volunteers form that was sent home for the excursion, please complete and return to the office. You will also need to show your photo ID

to the office.

Cameras: If your child is going to bring their own camera (mobile phones are not al-

lowed), please ensure they know how to work it and remind them about taking

care of their own belongings.

Gift Shop: Students are allowed to go to the gift shop in their small groups. If your child

is bringing money to the excursion, we ask that they are careful with their be-

longings and keep their money in a safe place in their bag.

Please try and provide your child/children with a suitable breakfast for a bus trip.

Toast and juice may sit better than a breakfast of cereal and milk.

We are looking forward to an exciting day and wish to thank parents for their support.

Considerations when choosing sunglasses for best protection:

- Choose sunglasses that meet the Australian Standard AS/NZS 1067.1:2016 with a lens category of 2, 3 or 4.
- Some sunglasses are marked with an Eye Protection Factor (EPF). An EPF of 9 or 10 provides excellent protection.
- Wrap around, close fitting and large lenses help to reduce reflected UV radiation and glare that can pass around the edge of sunglasses.
