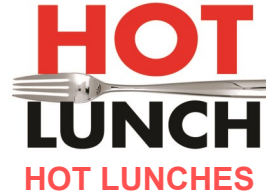

At our parent/carer focus groups on Thursday afternoon, many parents expressed interest in being able to further support and help their children at home with their learning.

With the introduction of the new Years K-2 English and Mathematics Curriculum this year (and the Years 3-10 in 2024), we will be providing parent/carer literacy and numeracy sessions throughout the year to assist our parents in understanding these new ways of teaching and learning and give you strategies to support your children at home.

THESE SESSIONS WILL BE ENTIRELY VOLUNTARY, and will run throughout the year on different days and different times. And of course, teachers and myself will ALWAYS be there to answer your questions and support at other times.

The first of these sessions will run tomorrow, Thursday 16 February, straight after school until 4:15pm. Mrs Lane and Mr Braye will be giving you information on how reading is now taught under the new syllabus, and strategies to use at home. I will be supervising any students in the playground.
